

# Official Rules and Entry Form for SSW's Scroll-A-Fairy Contest

## CONTEST RULES

- Finished projects can be made of any wood or non-wood material.
- Scrollers may use any technique, including but not limited to intarsia, fretwork, relief, overlay, inlay and compound cutting.
- The finished piece may measure no more than one foot in any direction.
- Scrollers may submit up to two entries.
- All projects must be accompanied by a completed entry form.
- Each entry must be the original and sole work of the entrant.
- Each project must be clearly and permanently marked with the entrant's name.
- All projects must be submitted by February 10, 2004. Please send projects to *Scroll Saw Workshop's* Scroll-A-Fairy Contest,

1970 Broad Street, East Petersburg, PA 17520.

- Winners will be selected by the staff of *Scroll Saw Workshop* based upon design, creativity, scrolling skills and overall appearance. Projects will be returned to the entrants in their original packaging. Fox Chapel Publishing and *Scroll Saw Workshop* are not liable for any lost, damaged or misdirected packages.
- Voting for the People's Choice Award will be held online at [www.scrollsawer.com](http://www.scrollsawer.com) from February 15, 2004 to February 27, 2004.
- Winners will be notified by March 1, 2004, and will be featured in a future issue of *Scroll Saw Workshop*. They will also be announced on *Scroll Saw Workshop's* website, [www.scrollsawer.com](http://www.scrollsawer.com). The Grand Prize

winner will receive a complete library of Fox Chapel Publishing's Lora S.
